 - This verse emphasizes addressing issues directly and privately before involving others
 - Proverbs 25:9 "If you take your neighbor to court, do not betray another's confidence."
 - This passage highlights the value of privacy and confidentiality when resolving disputes.

- Ephesians 4:26-27 "In your anger do not sin: Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold."
 - This scripture encourages resolving conflicts quickly, ensuring timely reconciliation.
- James 1:19 "My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry."
 - This verse emphasizes thoughtful communication and patience in resolving concerns.
- Center for Creative Child Care (CCCC) Below are items that will need to be discussed in more detail
 - 2025 will be the 50th anniversary We will celebrate
 - Reviewed the guiding principles that we need to amend to include the CCCC onto the SLB
 - An at-large member of SLB (J.T. Rice) creating a liaison and team serve in that capacity for their term on the SLB
 - CCCC Advisory Board that this at-large member would also lead (not decision-making, more support and guidance)
 - Add section 6.6 to be the Governance of the CCCC
 - The CCCC Bylaws may need to be folded into the SLB guidelines
 - Facilities will always be involved in the CCCC but they have a good communication plan in place already
 - From SLB:
 - o HR
 - o Finance
 - Continue as a ministry of the church
 - Current hourly payrate is \$10.50/Hr bi-weekly Kim provided a suggested increase
 - Raise Tuition
 - Christopher reached out to other centers to ensure we stay in line
 - Current tuition is \$130/week, Toddler \$140/week with 2 snacks and lunch, PT \$29/day, \$32/day for toddlers; \$18/day for mornings only
 - Do we want to continue part-time options or only full-time?
 - Kim estimates 40% are PT
 - o Do we want to look at who is PT and why? Send out a survey?
 - Does eliminating PT take away the opportunity for daycare that teaches about Jesus?
 - New marketing
 - Assistance may be available for tuition
 - Scholarships?
 - Kim, J.T., Shawn, and Amber will meet in the next few weeks to brainstorm
 - Chris Jones offered help with Excel
 - "Step Up to Quality"
 - Paperwork, Inspections, more assessments, new curriculum, training, observations
 - If providing Title 20, extra money for Title 20 children
 - We currently have the option to participate in this program since we do not have 21% Title 20 children
 - Kim is evaluating whether to follow this program decision must be made by July 1, 2025
 - Does not currently play a role in whether parents choose to bring their kids as there is no real awareness of the program
 - We can consider updating the employee handbook for checks and balances
 - Kim and Christopher will discuss the program further
